CAMP DETAILS FOR PARENTS

Transportation? We will be providing transport through our church's 15 passenger van and parent transport. We will meet for drop off and pick up at the church playground. It is important to be on time because we will leave promptly.

Swimming Safety? We will have each child take and pass a swim test before they are allowed to swim on their own. We will have adult supervision and clear guidelines of where swimmers/boaters can go. There is a life guard at Pioneer Park.

Cost? We are asking \$20 for each child. Cost will include transportation, snacks, activities, craft supplies, game supplies and prizes.

What should my student bring? Please bring a Bible, sack lunch and water bottle every day. Each day will also include water activities so please bring a swimsuit*, towel, sunscreen, good walking shoes (and water shoes, if they wish).

* Girls should wear a one piece or tankini.



Memorize one section of Philippians 2 (1-11 or 12-18)

PHILIPPIANS

Christ's Example of Humility

1 So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, **2** complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. **3** Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. **4** Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. **5** Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus,[a] **6** who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped,[b] **7** but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant,[c] being born in the likeness of men. **8** And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. **9** Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, **10** so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, **11** and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, **13** for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

14 Do all things without grumbling or disputing, **15** that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, **16** holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor in vain. **17** Even if I am to be poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrificial offering of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with you all. **18** Likewise you also should be glad and rejoice with me.
